IMPORTANT NOTICE!! -

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

We will be changing our clinical system from EMIS to VISION at the beginning of March.

This change has been made by the Scottish Government and will be happening across Scotland.

From **Thursday 12th March – Friday 20th March** we will have read only access to the medical record system while the transfer of data to the new provider takes place.

Please see below important points to be aware of :

- We will be offering **emergency appointments** only from **Monday 16th March until Friday 20th March** during this time.
- We ask that you order your repeat medication in **plenty** of time. Please request all medications required by **Tuesday 10th March**
- We will **not** be accepting new patient registrations 2 weeks prior and 2 weeks after- from 2nd March until 2 weeks after 6th April.
- We will be **unable** to receive any electronic results or letters from the hospital or any other health facility.
- We **cannot** provide any copies of medical records or provide any reports for private companies.
