Cervical Screening

Cervical screening ('smear test') is a test to check for cervical cancer caused by the human papilloma virus (HPV), which is very common and easily spread.

In Scotland, the cervical screening age has now risen to 25. The frequency of cervical screening tests in Scotland changed in 2020. It's important to attend for cervical screening every time you're invited. You'll be invited for routine screening every 5 years.

People who have changes that need to be monitored will be offered screening more regularly.

Zero Tolerance

We have a zero tolerance policy towards people who are violent or verbally abusive to our staff or other people on the premises.

Behaviour of this kind will result in removal from the practice list and may result in police action.

Community Link Worker and Advice Works

We have a new community link worker who is in the practice on a Wednesday Lucia Kelly. Lucia is able to offer non-medical support with personal, social, emotional and financial issues. These include low mood, anxiety and stress, social isolation, money and poverty issues, and bereavement. Please enquire with reception. Also Advice works can assist with money and debt issues including budgeting, negotiating with creditors, and mortgage and rent arrears - as well as checking you are getting all the benefits you are entitled to.
